Re: 'Llangennech & Bryn Sports Association

A grant of £8,000 was agreed in principle, subject to conditions being met.

Background

The FAW Trust has been awarded an allocation of £300,000 by Sport Wales from the Welsh Government's Facilities Fund for Sports Facilities.

As this is only a relatively small allocation of capital funding, the FAWT is focussing on projects that it believes could deliver exemplar projects and help make the case for continued future investment into grass roots club and community football.

Llangennech FC

The project will see an improvement to an area of land, currently unused, at the rear of Llangennech Park for the club to develop as a dedicated football training facility for all club teams' and a fixture venue for their mini and junior football teams. Alongside this the club would purchase portable floodlights to ensure that the facility can be used all year round as a home for all teams within the club.

£8,000 to develop a small-sided grass pitch and portable floodlights.

Panel Decision

A Fund of £8,000 was agreed in principle, subject to the following conditions being met:-

- Three quotations from floodlighting suppliers.

- confirmation of a minimum ground tenure of 10 years;
- sufficient reassurance being provided on how the asset would be protected.
- Confirmation and evidence of partnership funding

Funding of £8,000 would be reserved until the above conditions had been satisfied.

Can these be sent to the FAW Trust within the period of two (2) months from the date of this letter, unless The FAW Trust has given an extension of time in writing. Time will be of the essence in this regard.

Please note, this letter is only an in-principle commitment and does not constitute a formal offer of grant from the FAW Trust towards the financing of the proposed project.
