Thank you all very much too for your responses to clarify the situation today. It sounds encouraging.

In a nutshell, I am making a tentative enquiry on behalf of the LBSA, a community driven charity organisation in Llangennech, South Wales. Our local public park is home to the community court (built circa 1991) and the land is owned by the local community council. We have now been invited by them to collaborate in order to source funding to regenerate the court, which is in an unusable state and has become a hazard, a site for irresponsible dog walkers to leave their dogs off the leash to foul, and has generally been vandalised having become a haven for anti social gangs. Weeds and foliage is growing through the surface and it is in real need of either repair or removal.

I am tasked with researching and making contact with potential sources. I appreciate you await further detail in April, and any further information would be greatly appreciated. If we could be added to any lists having shown an expression of interest, it would also be appreciated.

Thanks for the update, I think you could consider proceeding with an application to Sport Wales now for the funding to renovate the court. The Be Active Wales grant is the opportunity I would pursue. You will need to make a good case around renovation and play on the derelict nature of the court, this is not a simple resurface – the court is unusable currently.

Take a look at the information [here](#) and my colleague Stuart Baker would be more than happy to assist. You would need three quotes from contractors before proceeding and would need to consider the match funding amount (this varies depending on how you need).

I was under the impression that, due to the specific nature of the project (being a Tennis Court Refurbishment), then it might qualify for the Government, LTA/TW specific grant.

Should our contact with Sport Wales not be fruitful, would we be able to further discuss the fund with you when there is more clarity on the finances, or is it the case that the project we propose is too much of a stretch to meet the requirements of the LTA grant (i.e. if indeed it does require more than just resurfacing)?
