Thank you for your recent stage 1 application to Postcode Local Trust.

We appreciate the time and effort which has gone into your application, however, after much deliberation on this occasion your application has been unsuccessful.

The primary reason for this is that we receive a high number of applications for our grants and whilst we would love to support all groups, it is unfortunately not possible with the funds available. We received an 11% increase in applications in this funding round.

The assessor of your application noted that:

The proposal had a clear link to the 'Increasing community access to outdoor space' theme

The assessor also noted that:

The total project cost and amount requested from the trust did not have a clear link to the activities detailed in the proposal.

The assessor felt that focusing on the above would strengthen a future application.
