Hi Benson,

It has been a while since our discussions over the 3G pitch endeavour! I hope you remain well, under the current circumstances.

I'm contacting you today via our familiar LBSA community group email account. As you'll be aware, the LBSA is a charity that was formed to improve communications between Llangennech & Bryn's community grassroots sports clubs, schools and community groups. Since its establishment, the links between such groups have much-improved and we have already achieved much to bring together and nurture relationships and help grow clubs and their limited facilities. For example, we now have responsibility for the full maintenance and budget of the sports field at Llangennech Park and are also working with all stakeholders towards a CCTV system for the benefit of all there.

In the spirit of that continued development, I contact you today on behalf of Llangennech Football Club specifically, with regard to an enquiry about the potential for the long term use of land within the grounds of St. Mikes as a football pitch.

The club has undergone an extensive growth program since 2018, and now boasts three men's senior teams, nine mini and junior age grades, veterans and walking football sessions, as well as a newly-established Girls section with teams aged U8, U10 & U12. As a result, the club has somewhat outgrown its facilities. However, the club would like to propose an idea to you with regards to the lower field on your site.

My understanding is that the club is working on a mutually-beneficial proposal that will include Llangennech AFC financing and maintaining a football field on said area, and - should you convey an interest in discussing such a project - I will happily put you in touch with the relevant club Officers to further discuss it and explore such options. You'll already be familiar with Emyr, who is the Communications Officer of the LBSA, and also involved with the football club, so I'm sure will be heavily involved in any discussions.

Please let me know, and I'll be sure to progress the matter with the club.

Thanks for your email, I hope you're well. We've been pleased to support the club lately with evening practice facilities.

The school's ownership changed two years ago and for the past few months we have been looking at what we can do to develop the site. There is currently an evaluation in process, which would mean we are unable to explore entering into any joint partnerships just now. It could be that once I know the outcome of this process, which will hopefully by the autumn, we can then explore if there are any possibilities. One of our long term goals is to get a 3G pitch, but we are more keen in the short term to secure a sports hall on site for now.

I will let you know if the situation changes as we would be keen to work with LBSA on a greater level.
