We are looking at the regeneration of an area of wasteland at the park in order to increase access to green space for a community lacking in facilities to meet the demand of a population of near 6000.

Give details about how you'll spend the money

The money will go towards clean and re-grade of ditches, cutting back hedge and treatment of Japanese Knotweed; spray of vegetation, surface stone bury and import of 150 tons of sandy soil or sand. Then followed by a surface grade, aeration, grass seed establishment and a soil chemistry alteration procedure. Mobile floodlighting system and storage facility will also be sought following groundwork
