Hope you are well. We are glad to see the maintenance programme has commenced at the park. I appreciate the plan you set out was to do as is done every year.

The LBSA has discussed with rugby and football clubs and are all in agreement that the field would benefit from a treatment of topsoil this summer especially under such circumstances where it has had an unforeseen rest.

We have sought advice from Dewi on this matter and had a cost of £1300 in order to supply and carry out the work sufficiently.

Would the council be prepared to cover this cost out of the annual budget set aside for the maintenance of the recreation pitch? We have been advised that we would need to move fast on agreeing this as soil supplies are short and the already-scheduled seeding and fertilising needs to be completed post-spread. Additionally, should the council feel unable to fund this from the allotted budget then the LBSA would initiate a conversation between the clubs who may, again, consider covering the costs of the maintenance; therefore I'm sure you will appreciate the urgency on this and if we could get a swift response either way then that would be greatly appreciated.

The budget sum for maintenance for 2020/21 is £5000. We have already and/or in the process of carrying out work on the field costing a sum approaching £4500. This covers weeding and feeding, verti draining and applying 80 tonnes of sand/seeding and slitting. This is in the first few weeks of the new financial year. and there will be other work required during the year. The Council could not commit to the request of top soil applying at a cost of £1300 at this point in time. The closure of the Bryn Hall, Pavilion and the Community Centre will have detrimental effect on the finances of the Council with the loss of hire fees for these buildings.
